This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey approval of the Board for Fresh Affiliation Up to Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 03 (one sections each in Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively). The total number of sections of the school from class I to X shall be restricted to 10. The optimum number of students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension.
2	The school has only 10 classrooms and not running bal-vatika presently. Thus, the school is required to construct 03 more classrooms with size of minimum 500 sq ft for bal-vatika within 03 months and submit videography covering the newly constructed classrooms along with an undertaking that from upcoming session school will start to run bal-vatika in the compliance.
3	The mathematics lab has insufficient workstation and seating arrangement . Thus, the school is required to upgrade the mathematics lab with more number of workstation and seating for students within 03 months and submit the compliance.
4	The school has converted regular cubicles into CWSN toilets which are very narrow and there is no room for a wheelchair/walker to navigate. Further, there is lift installed, but functionality of the same from inside has not been covered in the videography. Thus, the school is required to re-construct the CwSN toilets separately for boys and

	girls on each floor with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair (inside the cubicle) along with handrail on both side and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPwD Act and board's guidelines within 03 months and submit a video link covering the lift to access upper floors and all the CwSN toilets the compliance
5	The school has made a student sit on the wheelchairs to show the provisions relating to the facilities for CwSN, which is inappropriate and unacceptable. Thus, the school is required not to indulge in such activities in future and submit an undertaking on its letter head in this regard along with within 03 months in the compliance
6	There is construction work going on in the school's premises. Thus, the school is required to ensure that said part should be barricaded for access of students for safety purpose and complete the construction work within 03 months and submit the compliance
7	The school is required to maintain general up-keep in the school premises and submit the videographic evidence within 03 months in the compliance.
8	The school is required to maintain the admission register and attendance registers of all the classes and submit the copy of same within 03 months in the compliance
9	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Patna and submit the compliance within 03 months.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
